RULES & REGULATIONS

RULES

- WPA rules of play
- Lag for the opening break, alternating breaks
- Rack by referee using the triangle rack provided.
 - o athletes may not approach or inspect the rack.
- 30-second shot clock on the feature table only. For the other tables, the referee will monitor and enforce the WPA slow play rule if necessary.
 - Extended 60-second shot clock after the break.
 - o One (1) 30-second extension per game
 - The shot clock begins when all balls have come to rest, and the opposing athlete sits in his or her chair.
- Each round of play is scheduled for 2 hours.
- No open practice is allowed at all on the arena table. The two athletes scheduled on the arena table may shoot one rack each prior to the match.
- Between matches, athletes may practice with alternate racks until match time.
- If a table does not become available until match time or later, athletes may shoot one rack each prior to beginning the match.

FORMAT

STAGE 1

- 24 athletes. Random draw.
- Double elimination to the final 8 athletes (4 on winners' side & 4 on the one-loss side)
- One set, race to 6 for Girls and Under 17. Race to 7 for Under 19.

STAGE 2

- Final 8 athletes from Stage 1. A new draw will determine the bracket placement.
 - The 4 winner athletes will be draw against the 4 athletes from the looser side.
- Single elimination
- One set, race to 6 for Girls and Under 17. Race to 7 for Under 19.

DRESS CODE FOR WPA WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS

Pants

Long dress pants; no shorter than 2 inches above the ankle. Women may wear skirt or dress which cover the knees.

Colors: neutral, solid colors – beige, brown, dark blue, dark green, gray and black.

<u>Denim material is not allowed</u> except dark black color and not ripped.

Shoes

Clean black shoes (incl. black sole)

Closed toe shoes

Sandals / flip-flops / crocks (or similar) are not allowed.

Shirt

Clean collared sleeve (long or short) shirt or polo of any color. Shirt or polo must be tucked in. Women may wear an elegant top, a blouse or a dress which needs to cover the shoulders. A full zipped jacket is allowed (hoodies are not allowed).

<u>T-shirts are not allowed.</u>

Same logo rules apply to shirt, polo and jackets.

No hats allowed.

Logo

Up to 6 commercial sponsors spots 6 sq/inch or 38.4 sq/cm Up to 3 apparel manufacturer logo 3 sq/inch or 19.2 sq/cm

If a manufacturer logo is bigger than 3 sq/inch or 20 sq/cm, it will account for a commercial logo.

Available spots for logo:

Front

- 2 in left chest
- 2 in right chest

Sleeve

- 1 on left sleeve
- 1 on right sleeve

Collar

- 1 on left collar
- 1 on right collar

Back

- 1 in the top of the back and ONLY for apparel manufacturer logo
- player's name, country's name or flag.

Organization reserves the right to decide if an outfit is not authorized.
